






Dear IJHS community,

In 2024, we continued to grow. The 2024 IJHS Global Student Leadership Council (GSLC) welcomed 25 student leaders—up from 19 the previous year—with increased gender diversity and regional representation. Applications tripled to 72.

At the national level, our Country Student Leadership Councils (CSLCs) laid the groundwork for **long-term community engagement.** From expanding access to education to launching environmental initiatives, these councils have unified chapters and coordinated projects that are already positively impacting hundreds of lives.

The momentum carried through our **Young Achievers Leadership Academy (YALA) program**, which saw the participation of 145 students from 14 countries. From tackling mental health stigma to building educational equity, these changemakers brought energy and innovation to every phase of the program.

In 2025, we are focused on scale and depth. Five new CSLCs will launch this fall in underrepresented regions, including **Southeast Asia and West Africa**, extending leadership development to an estimated **1,200 new students**. We're also introducing targeted **micro-courses** in digital storytelling, peer counseling, and project leadership to give every IJHS member the practical tools to lead change in their schools and communities.

Thank you for being part of this journey. Let's continue to nurture a generation of **thoughtful**, **capable**, **and committed youth leaders**.




International Junior Honor Society


